LOCAL TOWNS TO EXPLORE

Explore the Cotswolds  
at Your Own Pace

**STOW-ON-THE-WOLD**

A historic market town perched on a hilltop, known for its antique shops, charming tea rooms, picturesque square and sweeping views over the surrounding countryside.

*Approx. 10 minute drive*

**BOURTON-ON-THE-WATER**

Often called the 'Venice of the Cotswolds,' this idyllic village is known for its low stone bridges, the winding River Windrush, family-friendly attractions and bustling village green lined with cafés and shops.

*Approx. 15 minute drive*

**CHIPPING NORTON**

A lively market town with a strong local spirit, offering boutique shops, traditional pubs, a thriving arts scene and beautiful countryside walks just beyond the high street.

*Approx. 20 minute drive*

**CHIPPING CAMPDEN**

A beautifully preserved wool town with golden stone buildings and plenty of heritage.

*Approx. 35 minute drive*

**KINGHAM**

A peaceful village with pretty cottages and award-winning pubs, perfect for a quiet lunch.

*Approx. 10 minute drive*

**CHARLBURY**

A tranquil spot in the Evenlode Valley with lovely walks and a welcoming local feel.

*Approx. 25 minute drive*

**MORETON-IN-MARSH**

A busy market town with plenty of shops, cafés and a popular weekly market.

*Approx. 15 minute drive*

**BROADWELL**

A quiet, traditional Cotswold village with honey-stone cottages, a central green and a timeless, peaceful charm that feels a world away.

*Approx. 5 minute drive*

**BURFORD**

Often referred to as the gateway to the Cotswolds, Burford charms with its medieval bridge, independent shops and riverside walks.

*Approx. 25 minute drive*

**THE SLAUGHTERS**

Upper and Lower Slaughter are two of the most picturesque villages in the Cotswolds, linked by a scenic walking path along the river.

*Approx. 15 minutes drive*

## Hidden Gems and Village Favourites

From charming antique shops dotted across nearby villages to artisan homewares in Stow, the area offers plenty for curious shoppers.

Pick up a scoop at Alfonso Gelateria, treats for four-legged friends at The Cotswolds Grooming Co, or stock up on fine ingredients at Daylesford Organic Farmshop, The Cotswolds Guy and D'Ambrosi Fine Foods. Stow also offers a quality butcher, cheese shop and a Tesco, while you'll find an Aldi in Moreton-in-Marsh and a Co-op in Bourton-on-the-Water.



# The Best of the Cotswolds on Your Doorstep

From Latimer Farm, many of the Cotswolds' most loved villages and destinations are within easy reach. Explore classic market towns such as Chipping Campden, Chipping Norton, Stow-on-the-Wold, Bourton-on-the-Water, Burford, Lechlade and Moreton-in-Marsh, or wander through the postcard-perfect villages of Lower and Upper Slaughter.

For food lovers, the area offers an exceptional mix of cosy pubs and refined dining, including The Old Butchers in Stow-on-the-Wold, The Fox at Oddington, The Wild Rabbit near Kingham and The Bull in Burford. Thyme in Lechlade is a destination in its own right, while Daylesford Organic Farm, Kingham and Charlbury are ideal for relaxed shopping and countryside experiences. Soho Farmhouse and Estelle Manor are also nearby, offering a more exclusive take on Cotswolds living.
